

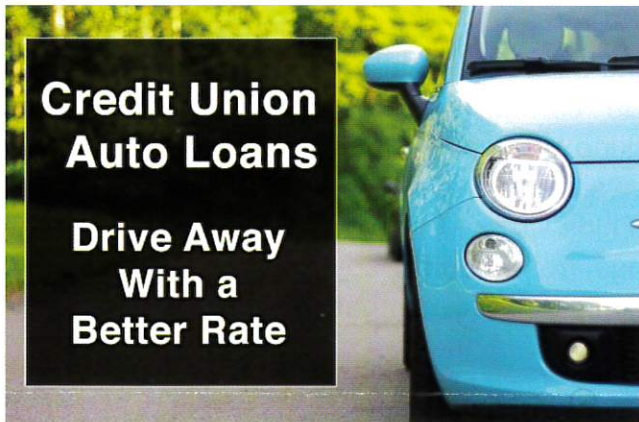

- It's Project Santa time again! Time for you to help us make it a happier holiday season for some less fortunate children in our community. Through the

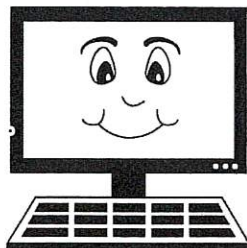
