Standing By Our Brave Young Warriors

Of 1.9 million Military children, approximately 225,000 will experience the challenge of having a parent/guardian deployed or absent for an extended period of time. We seek to celebrate and support as many of these amazing and resilient children as we can.

Working closely with Family Readiness Groups, our trademarked "Battalion Buddy" bears are hand-filled by volunteers and given to the children of deployed service members. Our cuddly Battalion Buddies wear tags that say "Hi Brave Young Warrior! I am your Battalion Buddy. I am here to cuddle with you while your Mommy or Daddy is away." The Operation Gratitude team and volunteers are often invited to FRG events to hand-deliver these special bears and show our brave young warriors and their parents that a grateful nation stands with them during difficult times.

HEALTHCARE HEROES

They can't stop - we won't stop!

In March of 2020 while the world faced one of the biggest and most devastating pandemics in over a hundred years we felt it was important to expand our first responder program to include healthcare heroes, as we recognize these brave individuals are also on a battlefield fighting an invisible enemy.

Operation Gratitude leads one of the largest coordinated efforts in the country to support the brave men and women serving on the COVID-19 frontlines, by delivering letters, food, coffee, comfort and hygiene items directly to major city medical centers.
